Dear Parents,
Bodies, bodies everywhere! Everywhere we look...it has been a busy 4 days in the Nursery class!

In the Discovery Center we are playing "Name that Body Part"...filled our classroom with the smell of gingerbread cookies ...Here's our recipe:

Nursery Gingerbread People

Blend until creamy: $\frac{1}{2}$ cup butter
 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup sugar

Beat in: $\frac{1}{2}$ cup molasses

In a separate bowl mix: $3 \frac{1}{2}$ cups flour

1 tsp. baking soda

1 tsp. cinnamon

1 tsp. ginger

1 tsp. pumpkin pie spice

$\frac{1}{2}$ tsp. salt

Add dry ingredients to the butter mixture alternately with $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of water. Roll dough and cut with cookie cutters. We added raisin eyes. Bake at 350 for about 8 minutes depending on the thickness of you cookies. The children loved the whole process but especially enjoyed adding raisin eyes and belly buttons to the gingerbread people!

In Art we are creating our life size bodies. This is a BIG project, which may carry us into next week. Our bodies will be displayed on the classroom walls. Come in and take a peek!
